## THE MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIP AND FINANCIAL AID PROGRAM

USA Junior Golf Federation recognizes that access and affordability to quality education, golf coaching and competitions are three of the most important factors to a junior athlete's future success. In keeping with the Federation's mission, we feel a deep responsibility in removing the financial barriers in golf that face much of today's youth. As a believer in the power golf can have on an individual, we are delighted to offer 12 deserving young athletes merit-based scholarships and financial aid offerings of up to \$95,000 per year to attend The Academy at GPC in Ridgefield, CT.

### What the Program Covers

- Tuition (Percentage determined on a case-by-case basis)
- Room and board
- Meals on The Academy campus
- 10 local, regional and national events per year that are conducted by:
  - Hurricane Junior Golf Tour (HJGT)
  - American Junior Golf Association (AJGA)
  - United States Golf Association (USGA)
  - US Challenge Cup Tour
  - PGA National and Sectional Events

### Program Conditions

- Merit-based scholarships and financial aid will be awarded for one, two or three academic years
- Merit-based scholarships and financial aid will be awarded on a case-by-case basis based on performance, including, but not limited to the below eligibility categories

### Eligibility Criteria

- Available to athletes graduating in 2024, 2025 and 2026 from traditional or alternative learning environments progressing toward graduation or completion of school curriculum
- Participates in recommended tournament schedule by The Academy
- Plans to enroll in two- or four-year college or university
- Maintains a GPA of 3.0 or better or equivalent to B average, (individual circumstances to be applied)
- Citizen of United States or lawful US permanent resident
- Demonstrates academic and leadership abilities
- Shows strong community service involvement
